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Dear Parent/Caregiver

The Kinross College Police Rangers will have their first camp at Ledge Point campground. This will occur on **Friday 31 March to Saturday 1 April 2017** (Week 9).

Rangers will be travelling to Lancelin, Guilderton and Ledge Point, initially for a variety of activities during the day. They will then stay at the Ledge Point caravan park overnight. We will return to Whitfords Nodes on Saturday morning where parents are invited to join the unit for some fun and games and a sausage sizzle for lunch starting from 10.00am. The aim of the camp is to promote Ranger rules and values (perseverance, leadership and team building), and also to welcome parents and families to be part of this great experience.

Rangers will need to be dropped off at Kinross College (assembling in the undercover courts) at **7:30 am on Friday morning**. Students will need to be **picked up from Whitfords Nodes at 12 pm on Saturday morning** or **families may join us from 10 am to meet the instructors join in and have some fun with a tabloid style event run by the senior rangers and have a sausage sizzle for lunch.
