I am pleased to provide you with the following details regarding our activities;

Dates: Start of Term 2 – End of Term 4 2018.

Drop off time: Rangers to be assembled in the College undercover courts no later than **1530hrs**, on all Wednesday afternoons when Rangers is operating.

Pick up time: Rangers will need to be collected by parents at **1700hrs** on Wednesday afternoons when Rangers is operating from Falklands car park.

Travel: Reputable bus charter services and Kinross College bus will transport rangers to and from activities. Should the need arise; we reserve the right to transport Rangers in a private vehicle.

Dress: Rangers are asked to wear **Rangers or College uniform with a hat and enclosed shoes (runners)** to begin all activities. Rangers will be advised if any other clothing is required for a specific activity.

Food: No food is required but a small snack can be taken with your son/daughter.

Activities: Rangers will participate in a range of outdoor activities; kayaking, snorkelling and rock climbing. *Due to the nature of these activities, it is important that **all sections of the permission slip and medical form be completed in full detail.***
