Dear Parent/Caregiver

The Kinross College Police Rangers will have their first camp at Ledge Point campground. This will occur on **Friday 5 April to Saturday 6 April (Week 9)**.

Rangers will be travelling to Lancelin, Guilderton and Ledge Point, initially for a variety of activities during the day. They will then stay at the Ledge Point caravan park overnight. We will return to Kinross College on Saturday morning. The aim of the camp is to promote Ranger rules and values (perseverance, leadership and team building), and also to welcome parents and families to be part of this great experience.

Rangers will need to be dropped off at Kinross College (assembling in the undercover courts) at **7:30am on Friday morning 5 April**. Students will need to be **picked up from Kinross College at 10:30 am on Saturday morning**.

Cost - The camp will cost **\$20** per student.

Supervision – will be provided by Ranger Instructors (teachers, school staff and volunteers) and parent assistance.
