



## KINROSS POLICE RANGERS ROTTNEST CAMP

Dear Parent/Care Giver,

The Kinross College Police Rangers will be having the end of year camp from Thursday 7 November to Saturday 9 November 2019. This camp will promote perseverance, leadership and team building. It also recognises the Rangers who have worked, behaved and attended at a high level all year.

Instructors will be offering a range of activities on the island including navigational exercises, swimming, snorkelling, cycling, beach activities, paddle boarding, night activities, 'Amazing Race' style challenges and some fun at the Aqua Park, Catamaran tour and Eco tour. Due to the nature of these activities, it is important that **all sections of the permission slip be completed in full and returned to College no later than Wednesday 25 September**. (Places are limited – getting slips in early will secure a position on camp).

The camp will involve a number of activities including cycling, beach activities, paddle boarding, snorkelling, boating tours and enjoying one of our state's best tourist attractions. We will be staying at the **campgrounds in tents**. Travel to and from Rottneest Island will be via Hillarys Fast Ferries, departing from Hillarys Boat Harbour, main Jetty at 9:45am on Thursday morning.

The camp will cost **\$50.00** per student as costs to visit the island have increased. **An additional cost for bike hire/transport is explained on the return form**. This \$50.00, plus funds from the Ranger budget will supplement the costs of activities, transport and food.

**Rangers will need to be dropped off and picked up from Hillarys Boat Harbour. This will involve students meeting instructors at 8:45am on Thursday 7 November and being picked up at 12:00 pm on Saturday 9 November. We ask that Rangers bring their own packed lunch and snacks for Thursday, and money to buy lunch on Friday. The meeting point will be outside the Hillarys Fast Ferries office.**

All of our **transport around the island requires the use of bikes**. There are two options.

1. Bring own bike – This will cost **\$15.00** for transport on ferry (this is additional to the \$50.00- **i.e. \$65.00**). The bike will **need to be road worthy** and appropriate for travelling long / hilly distances and your child will need to bring their own helmet, bike lock and puncture repair kit.
2. Hire bike – This option will cost **\$40.00** and includes a bike and helmet (this is additional to the \$50.00- **i.e. \$90.00**). **Please indicate on the return slip** if you are selecting this option for organisational purposes.

Instructors David Moss, Graham Gorman, Kim Alexander, David Macleod, Adam Gunnis, Sharayah Berecz, Hayden Grimes, Emily Elphick, Natasha Nicholson, Deidre O'Hayon, Sean Whitehead, James Bongiovanni will provide supervision on the camp. As well as junior instructors and parent helpers, who have been kind enough to volunteer their time.
